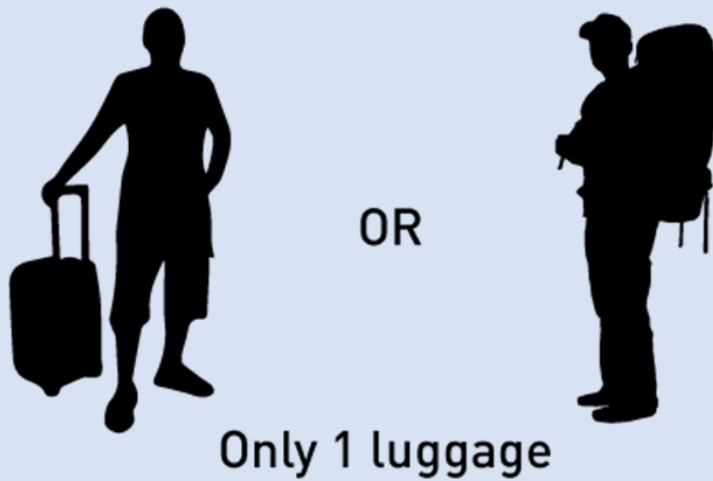

WHAT TO BRING

LUGGAGE

Participants can only bring ONE (1) large luggage (large backpack, camping bag, trolley bag, etc). Additional backpack is NOT allowed to ease the transferring process from mainland to the island as well as minimizing luggage damage or loss.



PERSONAL ITEMS AND HYGIENE

1. IMPORTANT:

a. **Original IC / Passport (for tour activities)**

b. **Sleeping Bag**

[The dorm does not provide bedsheets due to hygienical reasons. Thus, the sleeping bag will double a blanket & bedsheet.]

c. **Poncho**

[A form of light & disposable raincoat]

2. Toiletries (Must be packed in a toiletry bag.)

a. Soap and shampoo

b. Toothbrush & toothpaste

c. Cotton buds

d. Sun block

3. Towel – Recommended to bring microfibre / fast-drying towel



4. Water tumbler (1 litre)

5. Torchlight

CLOTHING AND ACCESSORIES

1. Sports attire

- x5 pairs (long sleeve shirt and track suits recommended)

2. Wet attire

- x2 pairs of microfibre, dry-fit or fast drying t-shirt & pants

3. Casual clothes

- x7 pairs (**Graphic t-shirts with vulgar prints are not allowed**)

4. Jubah/abaya and hijab (for sisters)

- Sisters are always to observe their awrah and modesty
- All clothing must be long-sleeved and loose fitting
- Jeans, tights and tight t-shirts are not allowed
- Hijab and clothing **MUST NOT** be transparent

5. FOR SISTERS:

- x1 pair of cultural clothing
- e.i (**Kebaya, baju kurung, cheong sam, sari, or any local traditional clothing**)

6. Optional: Sarong / kain pelikat / kain batik

7. Footwear

- x1 Sports shoes
- x1 Wet shoes (for water / wet activities), rubber shoes or water shoes



- x1 Sandal
- x7 pairs of socks

8. Laundry and plastic bags (for wet and dirty clothes)

9. For those with spectacles

- Safety band (for outdoor activities)

MEDICATIONS AND HEALTH

1. Allergy pills
2. Personal medication
3. Insect repellents (critical item)

NOTE TO PARENTS

1. Parents/guardians are **NOT ALLOWED** to get involve as participants in the camp or to visit the child/children during the camp.
2. This camp has a strict 'no-parent/guardians' at camp policy so as to not distract the participants during the camp. This is to ensure the participants are given the opportunity to be independent and express themselves effectively.
3. Mobile phones will be kept by the organizers from day-one to ensure that there is no interruption during the camp. It will be returned to the participants on the last day of the camp.
4. Parents are to **ENSURE** that the participants **DO NOT** bring the following prohibited items to the camp:
 - a. Media Devices (iPods, iPads, tablets, laptops, etc)
 - b. Portable Gaming Devices (PSP, Nintendo, etc)
 - c. Expensive Valuables (Jewelleries, expensive watches, etc)
 - d. Sharp objects (Blades, swiss army knife, etc)
 - e. Electronic cigarette / Vapes
 - f. Cigarettes and lighter
 - g. Any items of the same nature
5. A security inspection will be carried out upon arrival at the campsite. Should the organizers found participants possessing the items above, the organisers have the right to confiscate those items. The items will only be returned to the participants at the end of the camp. **THE ORGANIZER WILL NOT BE HELD RESPONSIBLE FOR ANY ACCIDENTAL LOSS OR THEFT OR DAMAGES.**
6. Possession of illegal substances (such as drugs) and engaging in illegal activities such as bullying, vandalism, theft; amounts to an **IMMEDIATE DISMISSAL** from the camp. Parents/guardians will be notified and are expected to pick up the respective participants from the camp site.
7. The camp is designed to bring the participant out from their comfort zone. Discipline will strictly be imposed on the participants during the camp.
8. The camp will be fully conducted in English. However, the facilitators are bilingual.



GENERAL ENQUIRIES

DO I NEED TO BRING ANYTHING FOR REGISTRATION?

Participants will only have to bring their original IC / Passport for registration.

WHAT KIND OF ACTIVITIES WILL THE PARTICIPANTS BE ENGAGED IN?

AKYC aims to educate the youth to prioritise the Deen and differentiate right from wrong through the lens of Islam, hence arming them with the correct knowledge to shield them on the Day of Judgment. We also promote a balance of fun outdoor activities such as river trekking, survival, tele-matches, treasure hunt, explorace as well as engaging in edifying discussions.

They are encouraged to reflect on the part they each play throughout the day in order to extract lessons from life. The objectives of these activities are to educate the youths on the importance of leadership, teamwork, and to promote creative thinking, developing the ideal Muslim youths for a better future, inshaAllah.

WHAT ARE THE SLEEPING ARRANGEMENTS DURING THE CAMP DURATION?

There will be separate accommodation for Male and Female participants. The participants will be sleeping in a dormitory type room. Each block is also equipped with toilet and shower.

WHAT ARE THE SAFETY PRECAUTIONS TAKEN DURING THE CAMP? DO YOU HAVE LIFEGUARDS DURING WATER ACTIVITIES?

The organizers require that all participants adhere to strict safety guidelines during all activities carried out throughout the camp. Qualified trainers and marshals will be present for close supervision.

WHO IS INVOLVED IN CONDUCTING AND COORDINATING THE CAMP?

The camp is conducted by FOQUS AKY Sdn Bhd who have years of experienced in handling camps and events for Al-Khaadem. Experienced trainers and instructors will be present as well.

HOW DO PARENTS CONTACT THE PARTICIPANTS DURING THE CAMP?

The parents may contact the facilitators in charge whom their numbers are provided in this info pack. However, this is highly discouraged, except for in emergency situations.
